Submission Requirements:

- Title page with author information, including names, titles, affiliations, addresses, email.
- Electronic copy of the manuscript in Microsoft Word™.
- Style must follow American Psychological Association (APA) guidelines.
- Maximum page length: 25 double-spaced pages including references.
- The manuscript submitted to *JSESD* must not have been submitted, either in part or wholly, elsewhere.
